CBBC Apartment Rental

The Clarklake Beach and Boat Club Apartment is available for members, their families and guests who are visiting. This upper apartment has a dining, living room and kitchen space with a newly remodeled bathroom. The two and half bedrooms can sleep up to five people. The

amenities include cable television, microwave, stove and oven, dishwasher and refrigerator. The beach is only yards away. This apartment rents for \$400 a week during the summer season and \$100 a week between September and May. A 20% rent deposit is required to hold a specific week. Check in

many new challenges including a variety of hills and obstacles in path of the balls. In addition to renovating the golf course, the golf club handles will have new grips.
